Greystones CNS Uniform Policy

Introduction:

This policy has been drawn up through a collaborative process involving the Parent Teacher Partnership, School Staff and the Board of Management of Greystones CNS.

It is important that our pupils learn to present themselves appropriately from an early age. A neat and tidy school uniform helps our pupils to understand the importance of presentation and helps them develop their self-esteem and self-confidence.

Greystones CNS endeavours to maintain the highest of standards in matters of dress code and personal appearance for all pupils in the school and as such uniform is expected at all times.

Pupils' Appearance:

Parents/Guardians should ensure that pupils comply with these standards at all times during the school term.

The school uniform is to be worn by pupils on all school days unless parents are notified in advance of a change. On P.E. days, pupils should wear the school jumper and marl grey tracksuit bottoms.

School Uniform:

- Marl Grey Trousers/Skirts/Pinafores
- White Polo Shirt
- Purple School Jumper/Cardigan with GCNS crest (Available at the School Wear House)
- Preferably Black school shoes with **velcro** (Marl grey socks/tights for girls wearing skirts/pinafores)

P.E. Uniform:

- Purple School **Jumper** and marl grey tracksuit bottoms.
- White Polo Shirt
- Trainers/Runners with **Velcro until your child is able to tie their laces**

During warm weather, grey shorts may be substituted for school trousers / track suit trousers.

Other Considerations:

- Please ensure that all uniform items are clearly labelled with your child's name.
- For Health & Safety reasons earrings are not allowed. Hair must be kept out of the eyes at all times and long hair tied back. Cardigans must not be worn on PE days.
